

# Ashawagh Hall June 2008

## "20th Anniversary Exhibition"

**Location:** Ashawagh Hall, Springs/Fireplace Road, East Hampton, NY

**Show Dates:** Sat. May 31 to Sun. June 8 (**nine-day exhibition**)

**Opening Reception:** **Saturday May 31 5 PM - 9 PM / Music starts at 6 PM.**

**Closing Reception:** Sunday June 8 3 PM - 5 PM

**Eligibility:** EEPG membership 2008 must be paid.

**Type of Work:** All types of photographic art. **All photos must be wired, framed and ready to hang.**

**Size Limitation:** Each member is allotted approx. 6 linear feet with no one piece larger than 42" wide (horizontal). Layout design left to the discretion of the hanging committee.

*It is recommended and encouraged that everyone drop off four to six pieces of your best work\*. The goal is to make the ENTIRE EXHIBITION look as good as possible. Hopefully all work will be hung, but the number of pieces hung will be determined by the number of participating photographers and the layout and design committee. \*Each member can also put 3 matted prints in our bin (max. 16x20 mat in protective plastic, etc.)*

**Fee:** \$150 per photographer\*\*

**Delivery of Work:** **Friday May 30 from 5 PM to 7 PM at Ashawagh Hall including labels (see below).** Also recommended are a typed price list of your work, a bio for our artist book as well as business cards or other promotional materials. **Labels:** **You must make your own labels** as follows: print in black and white (no color), 14 point (Title Case), Sans Serif font (Ariel or Helvetica) with **clear labels** (if possible) as shown:
